This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance an appropriate writ, order or direction most appropriately in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to ensure the safety and security of the petitioners, who are legally wedded couples as per Hindu Marriage Act and to protect the right to life and personal liberty of the petitioners as guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, learned State Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, who assures the Court that necessary action will be taken on the representation dated 08.05.2025 (Annexure P-7) after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, by passing a speaking order within a period of three days from today, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the instant petition any further.

The present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure as per law, in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.
