1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that they were studying with respondent No.6-School and they were transferred from Government School to Private School under the Chief Minister Haryana Equal Education Relief, Assistant and Grant Scheme (CHEERAG Scheme) launched 01.07.2022, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-1 but now, the benefit of the said scheme is not being granted to the petitioners on the ground that respondent No.6-School does not fall in the said "CHEERAG Scheme".

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners cannot be denied the benefit of assistance as, now the petitioners will be stopped from taking admission as they are already studying in A Private School and the said CHEERAG Scheme", will only be admissible in case,

the children from the Government School are transferred to the private school hence, the petitioners should be allowed to continue in the respondent No.6-School under the “CHEERAG Scheme” or should be transferred to any other private school under the “CHEERAG Scheme” keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance being raised by the petitioner have already been raised before the Deputy Commissioner, Mahendergarh at Narnaul in the representation dated 08.04.2025, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-6 but the same is still pending consideration with the respondent No.3 and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4 Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 08.04.2025 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the respondent No.3 within a period of **two weeks** from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
