By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to hand over the physical possession of the Institutional Property (Hospital & School site) No. PET, in Sector 45, Urban Estate, Gurugram II, after completion of development works/basic amenities.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already made representations dated 17.09.2024 and 24.04.2025 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) to the competent authorities, for redressal of her grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with her concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said representation(s).

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, appears on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, along with Ms. Ashna Singh, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3-HSVP. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 submits that the said representations/applications shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram (competent authority) to look into the pending representations dated 17.09.2024 and 24.04.2025 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
