Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-6) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Kaithal to Sirsa while ignoring the notified Transfer Policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even though the petitioner has secured 54.50 marks yet the respondents have issued vice versa transfer orders of one Sunali Lamba, who has secured 42.6 marks.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on instructions from Ms. Srishti Aggarwal, Assistant District Attorney, PWD (B&R) Department, Ambala acknowledges that the same was a mistake on the part of the respondent-Department and that they are taking appropriate steps to rectify the same. She further submits that the respondents are not going to implement the impugned order of transfer w.r.t. the petitioner in the meanwhile.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage, however, he seeks liberty to file the fresh petition as and when fresh/subsequent cause of action arises.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage with the liberty as aforesaid.
