Present revision petition has been filed against the order dated 13.10.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar vide which the application filed by the petitioner under Section 319 of Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 89 dated 08.05.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 307 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Salhawas, has been dismissed.

Learned State counsel at the very outset submits that trial in the FIR(supra) has culminated into conviction of the co-accused and at this stage, in view of the ratio of law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Satpal Singh Khaira Vs. The State of Punjab* (2023) 1 SCC 289, the power under Section 319 of Cr.P.C. cannot be invoked after conclusion of the trial. Thus, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Pending CRM(s), if any, are also disposed of accordingly.
