The petitioner has approached this Court seeking directions to the respondents No.2 to 4 to release the payment of death-cum-gratuity issued vide letter dated 03.10.2006 after computing the same and to release the further pension to the petitioner after applying 6th Pay Commission on the pension of the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Chandigarh as well as respondent No.3-General Manager Haryana Roadways, Yamuna Nagar are

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directed to decide the representation dated 21.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein by passing a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Chandigarh as well as respondent No.3-General Manager Haryana Roadways, Yamuna Nagar, are directed to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 21.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of two months.
