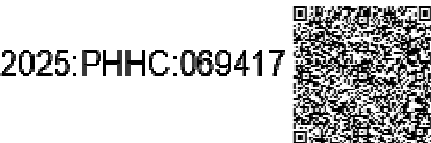

1 The application is allowed as prayed for. Annexures P4 & P5 are taken on record.

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2. This petition under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS, 2023) has been filed seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to register an FIR against respondent Nos.3 to 5 on account of having subjected the petitioner to illegal demands for dowry and for extending physical and verbal abuse to the petitioner for not meeting their demands and to take action on her representation (Annexure P3).

3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation (Annexure P3) before respondent No.2 raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be



satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Served with an advance copy of the petition, Ms. Guramrit Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course.
6. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation (Annexure P2) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
7. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide her adequate security in order to protect her life and liberty.
