1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to conduct free and fair investigation by considering the representation dated 11.04.2025, representation dated 19.04.2025 by RC/AD and same representation given on dated 21.04.2025 by hand, further representation dated 28.04.2025 and representation dated 01.05.2025, made by the petitioner before forming an opinion regarding the culpability of the petitioner in FIR No.70 dated 11.04.2025 under Sections 316(2), 318(2) & 351 (2) of BNS, registered at Police Station Sector-6, Dharuhera, District Rewari, got registered by the complainant, in respect of outstanding commercial liability and subsequent 03 FIRs i.e. FIR No.79 dated 18.04.2025, FIR No.80 dated 18.04.2025 and FIR No.81 dated 19.04.2025, at Police Station Sector-6, Dharuhera, District Rewari, based on same set of allegations. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the above mentioned representations, in a time bound manner and to submit the current status of the action taken in the said representations.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is a businessman who is running his business in Rewari. He submits that due to some commercial dispute, his supplier has lodged 03 FIRs i.e. FIR No.79 dated 18.04.2025, FIR No.80 dated 18.04.2025 and FIR No.81 dated 19.04.2025, at Police Station Sector-6, Dharuhera, District Rewari. He submits that for the redressal of his grievance petitioner has already filed a representation dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) before the Director General of Police, Panchkula which has been marked to Inspector General of Police, Rewari and the same is pending before respondent No.4 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Rewari, but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioners would be satisfied if representation dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Rewari is directed to decide the representation dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

6. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
