Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.29 dated 20.02.2025 under Sections 115(2), 324(4), 333, 351(2) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.
2. Vide order dated 14.05.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 16.05.2025 and she is not required for custodial interrogation.
5. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.05.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
