Petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents to give benefits of the 'Limited Cashless Medical Facility' notified by the Government of Haryana vide letter dated 20.11.2017, Annexure P-6, or under the prevailing Cashless Policy, 2024, Annexure P-8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been rendered infructuous, as the hospital has extended the cashless treatment facility to the petitioner in terms of the agreement dated 16.05.2025, entered into by the seventh respondent with the petitioner.

3. Learned State Counsel, on instructions, contends that the remaining medical reimbursement amount will be credited to the petitioner's account within ten days.

4. In view of the statement, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
