1. This order shall dispose of two petitions i.e. CRM-M-26117-2025 and CRM-M-26413-2025, as the same have emanated out of the same occurrence.

2. Present petitions i.e. CRM-M-26117-2025 and CRM-M-26413-2025 have been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking grant of regular bail in case FIR No.123 dated 01.09.2024, under Sections 109, 115(2), 126(2), 117(2), 351(3), 191(3), 190 BNS registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.



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3. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that main accused who was attributed grievous injuries has been granted the concession of regular bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 22.04.2025 i.e. Kamalpreet Singh Alias Kamla in CRM-M-54770-2024 (Annexure P-5). He further contends that the petitioner, Manoj Kumar @ Mojji @ Monu has been attributed of causing injury by pelting stones on the back of the complainant's brother namely Sahil Bansal. Whereas, petitioner Harjinder Singh @ Happy @ Rajinder Singh has been attributed of causing injury with stone on the right leg below the knee and the consequential injuries suffered by the injured was declared simple in nature.

He also contends that parties have entered into compromise and said fact can be confirmed from the counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant. Petitioners are inside the jail for the last more than 10 months and therebeing no material progress in the trial, prays for grant of regular bail.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant endorses the factum of compromise between the parties and submits that there is no objection if petitioners are released on regular bail.

5. Learned State counsel expresses his inability to confirm the said factum of compromise, as there is no such information with him. However, does not dispute the fact that the injury attributed to the petitioners is found to be simple and the co-accused Kamalpreet Singh Alias Kamla in CRM-M-54770-2024, who was attributed the grievous injury has already been released on bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 22.04.2025.

He also confirms the fact that petitioner is inside the jail since 02.09.2024 and till date process of recording of statement of the witnesses has not



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started.

5. As per the totality of circumstances, and the facts/allegations levelled against the petitioners, and the factors noticed hereinabove, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of bail to the petitioners.

Consequently, prayer made in the present petitions are **allowed**. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Illaqa Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned, if not required in any other case.

6. Needless to observe that the petitioners shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witness in any manner directly or indirectly.

7. Any of the discussion done and recorded hereabove, shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the facts of the case. Therefore, trial Court is expected to decide the case by taking an independent view, on the basis of evidence available on record, as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

8. Both the petitions stand disposed of.
