This criminal writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India has been filed seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to protect the life & liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 9 (arrayed in the petition) and take action on his representation dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure P4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure P4) before respondent No.2 raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Served with an advance copy of the petition, Ms. Aakanksha Gupta, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure P4) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.
