This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.2 to 4 to transfer the Letter of Intent (LOI) dated 30.09.2015 (Annexure P-1) issued in favour of the petitioner for setting up a retail outlet at NH-65, LHS Hisar-Ambala to another land which has been purchased by the petitioner with concurrence of the respondents.
