Short prayer made in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No. 1 for forwarding the petitions (Annexures P-2 & P-3) filed under sub-Section (4) of Section 3-H of the National Highways Act, 1956 to the Principal Civil Court of Original Jurisdiction at SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab, so as to adjudicate upon the claim of petitioners towards apportionment of the compensation.

[2] Notice of motion *qua* respondent No. 1 only.

[3] On asking of the Court, Mr. Athar Ahmad, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1.

[4] Learned State Counsel, on telephonic instructions from Sh. Harminder Singh Hundal, District Revenue Officer, SAS Nagar, submits that the petitions (Annexures P-2 & P-3) filed at the instance of petitioners invoking sub-Section (4) of Section 3-H of the National Highways Act, 1956 shall be forwarded to the Court concerned within two weeks from today.

[5] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners concedes that no cause survives in the present petition.

[6] **Disposed off** accordingly.

[7] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done as per undertaking given on behalf of respondent No. 1, one-third salary of respondent No. 1 shall remain attached till the compliance is made.

[8] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
