The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to formally protect the last drawn pay of the petitioner as SS Master, consequently grant first and second ACP and release all financial benefits along with interest at the rate of twenty-four per cent per annum till realization. Further, not to initiate any action of recovery from him on account of grant of increments from 01.07.2009 to 30.11.2019.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 27.01.2025, Annexure P-6, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 27.01.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2-Director,



Secondary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
