Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.283 dated 16.11.2024 under Sections 115, 3 (5), 80 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and later-on challan has been filed only under Section 115 (2), 80 (2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station Sadar Ratia, District Fatehabad.

There is no representation on behalf of petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel representing State of Haryana produced *parvi* report dated 18.08.2025 and submits that as per instructions received by him, petitioner has been acquitted in aforesaid FIR vide judgment dated 24.07.2025 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad.
