1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent no.4.

2. On 16.05.2025, following order was passed:

“1. As per the contents mentioned in the present petition, petitioner No.2 is married to one Sukhraj Kaur, and from said marriage, they were blessed with three children, who are presently staying with Sukhraj Kaur, who is not even impleaded as respondent, in the present petition.

2. Counsel for the petitioners seeks an adjournment to take required steps in the matter.

3. On request, adjourned to 23.05.2025.”

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3. Thereafter, adjournments were sought on behalf of the petitioners to place on record the divorce decree obtained by Petitioner No. 1.

4. Today, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the petition, with liberty to file a fresh one with complete and correct particulars, along with all relevant documents.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as sought and recorded hereabove.
