In CRM-M-26801-2025, prayer is made for setting aside of the orders dated 05.06.2023 and 07.08.2023 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kharar in complaint NACT/406/2020 registered on 22.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) titled as “Naresh Kumar Versus Rajnish Kumar & Anr.” under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act, on the basis of compromise dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-6).
