1. Learned counsel for the appellant argues that the only grievance of the appellant is that the misconduct happened in the election i.e. the manipulation and interpolation with nomination paper, which took place when the Elections to the Society were held prior to the last election, no action has been taken by the authorities concerned despite an order of enquiry by learned Single Judge vide order dated 19.12.2022 into the said alleged misconduct.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant further submits that as the fresh Elections have already been held, the only prayer of the appellant is that keeping in view the Enquiry conducted into the allegations of misconduct of interpolation of the nomination of the appellant, keeping in view the result of the said fact finding enquiry, whatever action is needed to be taken by the Department, the same be extended the appellant in a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the Enquiry Report will be looked into as submitted by the Sub-Divisional Officer-cum-Administrator, Jainendra Gurukul Society (Regd.) Sector-1, Panchkula and whatever action is required to be done, the same will be done after giving a due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned in accordance with the law and the said process will be completed within a period of **6 months** from the receipt of copy of this order.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present appeal may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
