The petitioners assail order dated 28.03.2024 (Annexure P-8) vide which the National Consumer Redressal Commission at New Delhi issued interim directions regarding stay of execution proceedings during the pendency of the appeal.

At the very outset, learned counsels appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 3, 5 & 6 and respondent Nos.7 to 10 informed this Court that as of now, the main appeal itself, which was pending before the National Consumer Redressal Commission at New Delhi, during the course of which, impugned interim directions were issued, stands finally disposed off. The learned counsel have passed on a copy of order dated 28.05.2025 passed by the National Consumer Redressal Commission at New Delhi, whereby the appeals filed by the respondents have been allowed. The same is taken on record.

3. In view of the aforesaid position, i.e. the main appeals having been finally disposed of by the National Consumer Redressal Commission at New Delhi, the instant writ petition is rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of, as such. All pending application(s) also stand disposed of.
