The prayer in this petition under Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.282 dated 03.08.2024 under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines, Hisar.

2. The counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and, therefore, the petitioner be granted the concession of bail.

3. The Counsel for the State admits the fact that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. However, looking at the nature of the allegations, the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of bail.

4. The Counsel for the complainant admits the factum of compromise and submits that a total sum of Rs.45,00,000/- has been received by the complainant by way of full and final settlement and states that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.



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5. I have heard counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the fact that compromise has been arrived at between the parties, report under Section 173(2) Cr.PC already stands presented and petitioner has undergone substantial period of imprisonment, his further incarceration is not required.
7. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petitions are allowed and the petitioner-**Deepak Bhojan** son of Sh. Bhojan is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
8. The petition stands disposed of.
