1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.47 dated 15.04.2025, registered under Sections 125, 190, 191(3), BNS 2023 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.
2. Reply dated 03.07.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof, has been supplied to counsel opposite.
3. Vide order dated 15.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
4. Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that in compliance of the order dated 15.05.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial



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interrogation.

5. Keeping in view of the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 15.05.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
