To be heard along with CRM-M-6366-2025.”

The Counsel for the petitioner seeks two weeks time to comply with the said order.

A perusal of the order would reveal that the petitioner has already been granted 04 weeks on 27.05.2025.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to surrender positively by Monday i.e. 28.07.2025 and on doing so he shall be released on interim bail.
