1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.3 to 5 and to take legal action against them.

2. No ground is made out for issuance of direction as prayed for, as it is clearly discernible that the dispute, if any, between the petitioner and the private respondents is of a civil nature.
