1. On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

“In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order dated 07.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) by which, the claim of the petitioner under the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923 has been rejected.

The writ petition was filed in May, 2024 and has been listed for hearing seven times.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for respondents No. 2 to 5 submitted that the writ petition is not maintainable as remedy of appeal is available under the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923 which remedy has not been availed by the petitioner.

There is a written request for adjournment circulated on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner and that too without taking no objection from the other side.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 to 5 opposes the request for adjournment.

Keeping in view the totality of the circumstances, case is adjourned to 08.07.2025 with the clear instruction that in case no one appears on behalf of the petitioner on the adjourned date, appropriate order on the basis of pleadings already on record, will be passed.

Registry is directed to inform the learned counsel for the petitioner about the next date of hearing as well as the order passed by this Court.”

2. Today also, case was called twice but none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner hence, it can be safely presumed that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition
3. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
