



1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala and he shall be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

5. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
