Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution praying for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

2. This Court on 14.05.2025 passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel shall get instructions about the fate of representation dated 08.05.2025 (P-3).

Posted for 02.07.2025.

It is clarified that there is no formal notice of motion in this case .”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, Status report by way of affidavit dated 30.06.2025 of Mr. Rajesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-II on behalf of respondents has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the other side.

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4. Perusal of the aforesaid reply reveals that Manjot Singh (son of the petitioner) is facing various criminal cases and details of which are as under:-

5. Also transpires that now aforesaid Manjot Singh has left the country and settled abroad.

6. In such circumstances, to inquire the whereabouts of son of petitioner, Police are visiting the house of petitioner while performing their duties in accordance with law.

7. In view of the above factual position, no ground is made out to entertain the petition.

8. Consequently, there is no option, except to dismiss the petition “at this stage”.

9. Ordered accordingly.

10. The above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case in any manner.
