The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s) in case bearing FIR No.0027 dated 20.02.2025, under Section(s) 118(1), 115 (2), 127 (1), 191 (3), 190 and 351 (2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Sections 109, 333 and 61 (2) of BNS, 2023 added later on vide General Diary No.31 dated 25.02.2025, registered at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 20.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

3 Learned State counsel, on instruction from police official assisting him, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for the purpose of investigation.

4 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5 Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 20.05.2025 is made absolute.

6 However, the petitioner(s) shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
