1. Petitioners-Radha along with minor children filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of necessary direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of private respondent No.4 (husband of petitioner No.1).
2. It is pointed out that petitioners had sent representation dated 23.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) as well as representation sent through e-mail (Annexure P-5). Even, then no action has been taken.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On advance notice, Mr. B.S. Bali, Addl. A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of State, who confirmed that he has received the copy of petition along with representation. He further stated that said representation will be disposed by the competent authority within two weeks.

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5. In the light of this, present criminal writ petition is disposed of with the direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to dispose of representation dated 23.04.2025 (Annexures P-4/P-5) within a span of two weeks from the date of receipt of orders. In case, there is any threat perception to the petitioners then appropriate steps be taken as required.

5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
