Main case:

Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated
27.08.2014 whereby the representation of the petitioner against removal
from the approved list had been rejected and order his promotion as
'Assistant Sub-Inspector/General Duty' based on medical categorization for
colour blindness.

The instant writ petition was adjourned *sine die* to await the
final adjudication of Civil Appeal No.3938 of 2016 by the Hon'ble Supreme
Court.



Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties are *ad idem* that the said Civil Appeal preferred by the Union of India already stands dismissed vide order dated 01.05.2019 and colour blindness is no more a disqualification for further promotion in view of the judgment dated 28.02.2013 passed in a batch of Writ Petitions(C) including Writ Petition No.356/2013 titled as '**Sh. P. Suresh Kumar Vs. Union of India and others**' passed by the High Court of Delhi.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of in terms of the aforesaid judgment dated 28.02.2013 passed by the High Court of Delhi in the matter of **Sh. P. Suresh Kumar (supra)**.
