The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.244 dated 12.11.2024 registered under Sections 85 & 316(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.
