The present **second** petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.259 dated 03.09.2022, under Section(s) 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Batala.

At the very outset, State counsel contends that the trial is already at an advance stage and is nearing completion as 13 witnesses out of 15 witnesses cited by the prosecution have already been examined and the matter is listed before the trial Court on 24.10.2025 for examination of the remaining prosecution witnesses.

In view of above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to present the instant petition at this stage.
