The instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 0329 dated 15.09.2024, under Sections 103(1), 109(1), 115, 190, 191(3) and Section 351(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 61 and 117(1) of BNS 2023 (added lateron) registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad.

This Court vide order dated 29.05.2025, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 29.05.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Action taken report filed today in Court by learned State Counsel is taken on record. According to the aforesaid report, departmental inquiry has been initiated against the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further submits on instructions from SI Satyawan and SI Naresh Kumar that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

This Court is satisfied with the aforesaid report.

In view of the above, the order dated 29.05.2025 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
