Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to register the FIR against respondents No.5 and 6, as per law after conducting the fair and impartial investigation into the complaint dated 30.04.2025 (Annexure P-4)

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that on 29.04.2025, the petitioner sustained multiple injuries at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and other police officials, as he objected to the wrongly issuing of challan, when he was having all the documents. He contended that despite reporting the matter by mother of the petitioner to respondent No.4, no action had been taken, rather the petitioner is being pressurized to withdraw the said complaint.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if the representation

dated 30.04.2025 (Annexure P-4), which had already been moved before respondents No.3 is looked into.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 30.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) is looked into.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to look into the representation and to take appropriate action, if any required at the earliest.
