1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing impugned orders dated 08.07.2024, 13.07.2024 and 15.07.2024 (Annexures P-1 to P-3).
2. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 3 submits that restoration of provisionally attached bank accounts has been carried out and intimation to this effect has been issued to all the three respondent-banks on 18.06.2025.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that necessary action has not been taken by respondent-Banks, therefore, it is doubtful whether necessary intimation has been conveyed.
4. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 3 submits that e-mails in this regard have again been sent today itself and forwarded to learned counsel as well. Copies of communication dated 18.06.2025, furnished in Court today, are taken on record, subject to just exceptions.
5. Learned counsel, who represent respondents no.4, 5 and 6, in other matters before this Court, have been called upon, keeping in view the nature of this matter. Copies of said e-mails have also been conveyed to learned counsel for said respondents. Learned counsel for respondents submit that necessary steps shall be taken by respondents no.4, 5 and 6, in view of communication sent by the Department.
6. Keeping in view facts and circumstances as above, this writ petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
