This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an appropriate writ, order, or direction, particularly in the nature of *certiorari*, for quashing the order dated NIL (Annexure P/15), dispatched and delivered on 30.04.2015, passed by respondent No. 3, whereby the pension claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, fairly submits that in view of the law laid down by the Larger Bench of the Supreme Court in *Senior Division Manager, Life Insurance Corporation of India Ltd. and others versus Shree Lal Meena*, reported as *2019 AIR SC 350*, the controversy involved in the present petition is squarely covered against the petitioner. Learned counsel, therefore, does not press the petition on merits and prays that the same may be dismissed accordingly.

This Court has considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and has also perused the record. In light of the authoritative pronouncement of the Larger Bench of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Shree Lal Meena* (supra), the issue raised in the present writ petition no longer survives for adjudication.

In view of the above and in consonance with the binding precedent of the Hon’ble Supreme Court, the present writ petition is dismissed.
