ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (Oral)

1. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the appellant who is present in Court submits that the appellant will not press this appeal provided that he is granted 14 months time to pay the entire amount in a staggered manner in equated monthly installments by 10th of every month.
2. Learned counsel for respondents that he has instructions to grant one year time to the appellant.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
4. The appellant will pay the decretal amount along with interest in 14 equated monthly installments.
5. The appellant shall remain bound by his lawyer's statement. If any default is committed in repayment of any monthly installment, the decree holder shall be entitled to enforce the decree forthwith.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
