1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to consider them for promotion.

2. The petitioners claim that they joined Punjab Police as Drivers. They are working on the post of Drivers for more than 10 years. The candidate who joined alongwith them on other posts including Class-IV have been further promoted but there are no in promotional avenues for the Drivers.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab submits that a Committee was constituted to examine claim of the petitioners. A report has been received from the Committee and Competent Authority would, in due course, consider report of the Committee.

4. Mr. R.K. Arora, Advocate for the petitioners submits that



respondents may be directed to taken decision on the report of the Committee expeditiously.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to Home Secretary to examine report of the Committee alongwith law laid down by Supreme Court. Let the needful be done expeditiously and preferably within 06 months from today.
