SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of Constitution of India, 1950 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 & 3, to protect the life and liberty of the Petitioners as guaranteed under Article 21 of Constitution of India, 1950 and to provide adequate security and protection to the petitioners who anticipate grave and imminent threat at the hands of respondent No.4 as they are living in live-in- relationship against the wishes of respondent No.4.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jastej Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has produced a copy of speaking order dated NIL, however, the same is found to be unsatisfactory by this Court.

The petitioners who are present in Court, are directed to appear before SHO, Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, who further directed to give personal hearing to both the petitiones and thereafter, shall decide the representation dated 09.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) afresh with comprehensive particulars that too also after calling upon respondent No.4 namely Bowa Mukhiya, son of unknown, resident of Murkuchiya, Kisanpur, Ward No.01, District Supaul, State of Bihar. A copy of the fresh speaking order so passed, shall be communicated to the petitioners on that very date itself.

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the instant petition any further.

The present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure as per law, in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.
