SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners have a remedy of filing an appeal under Section 68-O of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, which they have not availed of.
2. Writ petition is dismissed, as not maintainable.
3. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to take recourse to the alternate statutory remedy as also to move an appropriate application before the appellate authority seeking condonation of delay.
4. Pending application stands disposed of.
