The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Contitution of India for directing official respondent nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent nos. 4 and 5.

Learned State counsel has submitted that speaking order dated 14.05.2025 has been passed by the SHO, Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural), which has been produced in Court accompanying by statements of parents of petitioner No.2 and statement of respondent Nos. 4 and 5, which are taken on record. Persual of the statement reveals that all the parties give no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and have also deposed before the police officer that the petitioner can live with each other without any threat from them.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to take alternate remedy, if required.

Dismissed as withdrawn.



However, the petitioners are at liberty to take appropriate remedial measures, if so advised, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).
