1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-3).

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Vashisht, APP for U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and Mr. Arun, Sharma, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the

parties, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the representation dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

7. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

8. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
