The petition has been filed to consider the petitioner's candidature for the post of TGT Sanskrit in response to advertisement 02/2023. The grievance is that the petitioner has teaching experience of working as TGT Sanskrit (C&V) on contract basis in a Government School, which has not been taken into consideration for awarding marks for experience under socio-economic criteria.

2. Learned State counsel, appearing on advance notice, contends that the Division Bench in LPA-1037-2023 titled *Haryana Staff Selection Commission v Rahul and another*, has quashed the policy of giving marks under the socio-economic criteria and experience for the recruitment in Government service. In terms of the law laid down the selection result was declared vide announcement dated 27.07.2024, Annexure P-5, only on the basis of written



examination marks obtained by the candidates without giving any weightage for socio-economic criteria including experience.

3. In view thereof, the petitioner cannot claim marks for experience under socio-economic criteria, which has been declared illegal by the Division Bench in the aforementioned judgment.

4. Dismissed.
