Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter to be referred as 'BNSS') seeking quashing of complaint bearing No. COMI-26-2022 dated 15.10.2022 filed under Section 295-A, 323, 506, 302, 511 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code (hereinafter to be referred as 'IPC') (summoned under Sections 323 and 506/34 of IPC) titled as *Dalbir Singh Vs. Balbir Singh and Others* and its subsequent proceedings including the impugned order dated 18.04.2025 (Annexure P-2), vide which the petitioner has been summoned to face trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to challenge the summoning order dated 18.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) by filing a revision petition under Section 440 of BNSS before the learned Sessions Court concerned.

In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

Further, in case the petitioner files a petition under Section 440 of BNSS by challenging the summoning order dated 18.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) within a period of 02 weeks before the Court concerned, the same shall be decided on merits, within a period of 04 weeks in accordance with law.
