This is Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent no. 1 & 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondent no. 4 to 11, who in collusion with respondent no. 3 are administering open threats to the petitioners and their family members to eliminate them and are trying to take forcibly illegal possession over the land sold by the petitioner no. 1 to petitioner no. 2, in the interest of justice.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail alternate remedies as available under Section 175(3) BNSS, 2023.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
