1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to count the service rendered by the petitioner from 27.08.1987 to 18.02.1997 with respondent No.3 as a qualifying service for the grant of retiral benefits.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner very fairly submits that written statement dated 01.04.2020 has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 and vide order dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure R-1) the claim of the petitioner has been rejected. He submits that in the light of the order dated 06.11.2023 passed by the respondents, he wants to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to challenge the same.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
