1. In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant all the retiral benefits i.e. leave encashment and gratuity.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a legal notice dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-11) has been served upon the respondents, however, no decision has been taken thereupon. He further submits, on instructions from the petitioner, that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.5 to decide the legal notice dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-11) in a time bound manner.
