1. The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner(s) seeking issuance of an appropriate writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay 30% additional pension as applicable w.e.f. 04.04.2022 onwards with further revision as applicable from time to time alongwith 12% interest per annum from the date it fell due.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that as regards his grievances mentioned in the petition, the petitioner(s) has already sent representations dated 20.11.2024 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) to the respondent(s) and he would be satisfied in case respondent No.3-The Accountant General (A&E) Haryana through its Senior Account Officer, is directed to consider and decide the said representations by passing a well reasoned and speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.
5. With the consent of the parties, the present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to respondent No.3-The Accountant General (A&E) Haryana through its Senior Account Officer, to take note of the representations dated 20.11.2024 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) sent by the petitioner and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties in accordance with law and preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of 01 month.
7. In the event of non-payment of dues within the said period, the same shall be released to the petitioner along with interest @ 6% per annum for the delayed period.
