AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. Petitioner has filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents No.2 to 4 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents i.e. respondent No.5 second husband of the petitioner and respondent Nos.6 and 7 friends of respondent No.5 who give beatings to the petitioner under the influence of liquor.

2. It is pointed out that petitioner is residing separate on the given address in the petition. She also filed representation dated 03.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) but no action has been taken.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance notice, Mr. Japjot Singh, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of State.

5. Learned counsel representing State of Punjab pointed out that the representation dated 03.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) will be disposed of by

the official respondents as per law, within two weeks.

6. Considering the aforesaid factual position, present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to dispose of the representation dated 03.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) within a span of two weeks as per law. It is further directed that in case petitioner apprehends any threat to her life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.5 to 7 then the same may be considered and appropriate steps be taken as required.

7. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
