1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) whereby he was dismissed from service by Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

2. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that appeal of the petitioner is under active consideration and final order shall be passed within one month from today.

3. Faced with this, Mr. Raj Kumar Arya, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw instant petition with liberty to avail remedies against order passed by Director General of Police.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.



It is made clear that if order is not passed by Director General of Police within 1 month from today, it would be viewed adversely because appeal is already pending for almost 4 years.
